### Koorrefrein:

**Blow ye winds in the *mo-or-ni-ing*, blow ye winds, Heig-Ho  
Haul away your running gear and blow, ye winds Heig-Ho!**  
( accordions herhalen telkens 2e regel refrein)

1. *It's advertised in **Bo-os-ton**, New York and Buffalo,
